Shalom! Dear fellow workers. To us as children of God I praise God for allowing me to enjoy freedom. I would like to share news about my family in August 2024.



August 15th is Korea's Liberation Day, and two later, August 17th, is Indonesia's Independence Day. It is the day that both Korea and Indonesia gained freedom from Japanese colonial rule.

Indonesian people, who were colonized by the Netherlands and Japan, consider Independence Day very special and hold festivals in every street and alley.

We, who were slaves to Satan, gained freedom through Jesus Christ. But the souls of the Sundanese, the world's largest Muslim people, have not yet known freedom.

I want to do my best to spread the name of Jesus Christ, who gives us freedom.

I helped senior missionaries with their ministry in July. I visited the areas called Sukabumi and Chippendui. I came back after serving as an interpreter there. I'm still studying the language and interpreting seems difficult. So I was hesitant. However, I held on to Paul's confession, "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me," and obeyed in faith. I was able to complete my interpreting service by the grace of God.

I believe that we can do all things through Jesus Christ, who gives us strength when we strive for the gospel.





A short-term ministry team came from Korea. During our ministry schedule, we visited Ciwidey (an area where there are no Christians among the 300 residents). This is a Muslim area, and it is an area where the gospel cannot be preached openly.

I was worried because it was the first time a foreign group had entered, but God guided me to get permission from the town mayor, and later, I was given permission to pray for blessings. In addition, the village residents were very happy through the shortterm team's service. This entire process was under God's guidance and grace.

Please pray that the kingdom of God will expand in the Ciwidey area where the first seeds of missionary work were sown. I believe that the one who started a good work in us will be able to carry it out.
