Hallelujah! It's been a while since we last connected. We sincerely apologize for the delay in updates. Still, God's grace—and your faithful prayers—have carried us this far.

We are truly grateful for your unseen support and intercession. Here's a glimpse into what God is doing here in our lives and ministry.

1. Hope Festival – Big Grace in a Small Town

Though our city has less than 600 Korean residents, we held a "New Life Festival." Despite doubts, God poured out His grace:

- 14 adults, 11 children, and 1 youth visited church
 - 3–4 families began attending regularly
- Please pray for continued gospel fruit, especially for those not yet attending regularly.

2. Youth KOSTA – Seeds of Change

We took our youth to KL for their first KOSTA camp. At first, worship felt unfamiliar—but by the end, hands were lifted in praise.

Their heartfelt desire to return every year touched us deeply. We believe God was delighted, too.

3. Bible Walk: The New Testament

This semester, we're walking through the entire New Testament.

Held on-site in the morning and online in the evening, this study helps deepen understanding of the Word and nourishes our spirits.

4. Short-Term Missions – Reaching Mardu

Two mission teams (Air Busan Christian Group & Shinin Church Youth) visited during the off-season.

We served "Victory Church" in the Mardu area—sharing the gospel, hosting foot-washing events, and spreading Jesus' love. The local church was deeply encouraged.

5. Bible Conference – Back to the Gospel

Despite financial constraints, we held a Bible Conference.

Pastor Jooho Seol (Love of the Lord Church, Gwangmyeong) reignited the call to the gospel and evangelism. Please pray that we become a church that revives lives through the gospel.

6. Family Month – A Focus on Home & Next Generation

In May, we held a family retreat and a Children's Day program with Shinin Church Youth.

Some families began attending church through these events. Our tradition of taking family portraits continues to bless many.
