We were also reminded that becoming a Christian in this nation requires giving up much—sometimes even one’s status or safety. Please pray that many Indonesians who now bow in prayer to other gods will one day confess Jesus as Lord, the true Savior who leads to salvation.

The Sunda people love ngopi (drinking coffee). In Sunda villages, people gather under a shelter to drink coffee and share long conversations. When we visit villages, locals often welcome us warmly, saying, “Mr.Chris, come inside and drink coffee with us,” and we cherish those moments of building relationships.

Yet among the Sunda, many still hold strongly to folk Islamic beliefs, and interest in Christianity can bring fear of social consequences. We pray that the Sunda will experience the love of Christ and that entire families will come to know Him. Please continue to pray for the Sunda people.

## after-school Ministry



We are preparing to relocate after-school class to a new location. At the present home where we meet, adults smoke during study time, making it difficult for children to concentrate. After searching with a local leader, we found a potential new place, but the bathroom must be rebuilt, and the space needs painting and repairs. We expect the move to be possible around February next year.

We also hope to add an English class after relocating. Thankfully, a senior missionary recently came and helped teach English for a month, giving our children a valuable learning opportunity. We were reminded again of God's grace in providing workers at the right time.

At our November gathering, God brought 10 more souls, and a total of 36 Muslims—including children—came together to worship. Hallelujah! We thank our partners who pray with us, and we give thanks to our Father God who answers those prayers.

During the last worship service, after the sermon, one Muslim participant said, "I think the Allah of the Qur'an and the God of the Bible are the same—just different religious terms for the same God."

There is no other God besides the one true God! Yet we rejoiced when we heard this comment, because we sensed God is calling them to hear the truth. We are planning to begin home visits with our worship members to start Bible study in their families.

On December 6 (Saturday), we will hold a Christmas service for the MBBs. We desire to share the joy of Christmas through the Word, especially with those whose faith is still young. In our previous prayer request, we asked for regular support for the MBB ministry. We are thankful that Soongin Church provided offerings for the needed equipment (projector and speakers).

**Language Study:** It has been two and a half years since we came as missionaries, but language learning feels endless. Missionary Chris is studying at UPI University, and Missionary Linji continues learning through private tutoring.

**Partnership with PARI (Sunda Evangelism Organization):** At the end of July, Missionary Chris received Muslim evangelism training at PARI together with local evangelists. In November, he met his training friends again after a long time. We plan to keep partnering with PARI to support and work with the evangelists who reach the Sunda people.

**Local Church Ministry:** We serve together with a local church and preach once a month. On December 13, the church will hold a Christmas outreach event to invite unbelievers in the neighborhood. Please pray that this will be a good opportunity for the members to share the gospel, and that those who come will hear the Word and be changed.
