Greetings in the Lord! As we step into 2026, OM East Asia has launched new projects for unreached people in 10 countries, and our focus is now on mobilizing financial resources. Esther will also serve through coaching ministries, strengthening the spiritual health of OM workers. Though we are missionaries ourselves, our calling is to serve other missionaries in their labor.

From January to early February, we were on sabbatical. During this time, our son Nathan and his wife Diane welcomed their first child, HaYoon Liana, on November 23—our first granddaughter and a precious gift from God.

We spent a month in San Francisco caring for her, reliving memories of raising Nathan years ago. With overflowing joy, we praised God for this beautiful child and celebrated her 100th-day milestone before returning to Thailand. We continue to pray that Liana will grow strong in faith and under God's grace, even as we press forward with ministry in 2026.



At the OM Korea Board meeting on March 3, we committed to the 2026 ministry theme, "Mobilizing Global Prayer." Monthly OM Global Prayer Gatherings will be held across Korea, beginning with Busan on April 10 and Seoul on April 12–13. EAA Leader Ashley will speak, with Woody interpreting. Pray these events inspire Korean churches and young people for mission.



We visited the OM Korea Busan branch after the board meeting, encouraging the staff and meeting two single missionaries faithfully serving. We were especially moved by Chaeyoung Lee, the widow of martyred missionary Jisung Jang, now studying theology while serving with OM Busan. We rejoiced in their unseen dedication, persevering in weakness yet laboring faithfully in partnership.



Despite the Middle East war, the OM International Leaders Meeting was held in Cyprus, March 12–19. It was a joy to see Korean missionaries' leadership recognized and young leaders emerging. Please pray for training and discipleship to reach the unreached.



On March 29, Thai ex-Omer Boaz will be commissioned to OM Laos at Immanuel Church, with OM Asia leaders joining in Mission Sunday. Pray for wisdom and financial provision.

From April 6–10, the OM East Asia Leadership Retreat will be held in Jeju, followed by Global Prayer Gatherings in Busan and Seoul, April 10–14. Pray that Korean churches and young people partner in world mission.

In May, Woody will visit Los Angeles and San Francisco to meet OM EA donors. Pray for fruitful meetings, safe travels, and health. May the joy of the Resurrection overflow in your lives.
